<p>1. Following the conclusion of the FFA Cup Round 4 match between SUFC and BCLFC at Sydney United Sports Centre on 14 April 2021, Spectators standing on the far side of the ground (or “the hill side”), an area traditionally occupied by Spectators associated with SUFC, ignited four flares, in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Offence Code 25-01 of the Football NSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations 2021 (<b>Regulations</b>).</p>	<p>1. <u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty <u>Determination</u>: <b>\$500 fine payable to Football NSW within 30 days of the date of the Notice of Charge</b></p>
