Charge(s)	Tribunal determination

The Respondent (Jacqui Bachelard) failed to follow reasonable direction from an official of Football NSW Employee or representative in relation to conduct and/or behavior at a match, hence, is in breach of section 15.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Number 8 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (Regulations).</p>	<p>1. <u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty</p> <p><u>Determination</u>: Two (2) fixture suspension.</p> <p><u>Reasons</u>: <i>The GPT found there was sufficient evidence to show that the Respondent approached the referee after the match and told the referee that the red card shown to the Northern Tigers player was unfair. She was asked to leave and further threatened the referee by saying "If you don't take the card off we will take this right to the top."</i></p> <p><i>The GPT's decision is based on the evidence from the match officials.</i></p> <p><i>The Respondent is required to serve a suspension of Two (2) Fixtures for Charge 1. The suspension applies to all Football related activities excluding spectating.</i></p>
<p>Costs:</p> <p>The Tribunal determined that the costs of the Tribunal, as determined by FNSW, be met by the Respondent.</p>
