### **Football4All Player Fees**

Fees listed for players with disabilities are applicable only to players registered in a Football NSW approved Club or Association-based program operating as part of the Football NSW Football4All programs.

All Football4All programs operating within Football NSW must be approved by the local Football Association and by Football NSW.

### **Important Information**

The Football NSW Capitation Fee represents the financial contribution registered participants make to Football NSW to enable it to provide a wide range of programs, benefits and services to them and to the broader football community.

Traditionally, the Football NSW Capitation Fee and the insurance component of the Football NSW Player Registration Fees have been separately identified. In order to better recognise that insurance cover is among the wide range of benefits and services provided by Football NSW, and to bring our processes into line with those of other Member Federations across the country, for the 2019 season and beyond, these two components will be merged into the “Football NSW Capitation Fee”.

Football NSW is pleased to advise that the Board recently resolved **not** to increase the insurance component of Football NSW Player Registration Fees for Community Football players for the 2019 season. While Football NSW has experienced an increase in its insurance premiums for 2019, the decision not to pass on the increase to Community Football players reflects the lower level of claims experienced by that group when compared with others.

Football NSW is pleased to also advise that the Board recently resolved also to **not** otherwise increase the Football NSW Capitation Fee for the 2019 season, meaning that the Football NSW Capitation Fee has either decreased or remained stable across various age groups since 2011.

This decision reaffirms Football NSW's desire to continue to provide high quality programs, benefits and services to its member-Associations and registered players without passing on increased operating costs.

As advised on 3 July 2018, Football Federation Australia (FFA) has increased the National Registration Fee (NRF) for the 2019 season (from \$12.60 to \$14.00 for Juniors and from \$25.00 to \$33 for Seniors). This is the first time since 2013 that FFA has increased the NRF. The increase is reflected in the above Schedule of Fees.

### **Schedule for Association Payments of Football NSW Fees**

- Associations to pay 60% of the total payment by Tuesday, 30 April 2019 (the Tax Invoice for this 60% payment will be issued by Football NSW based on 2018 registration figures);
- Registration fees will be calculated based on PlayFootball (the FFA's new online registration system) data as at 30 June 2019;
- Registration data will be sent to Associations for confirmation by Wednesday, 10 July 2019;
- Confirmation of registration data to be returned to Football NSW by Friday, 26 July 2019
- Football NSW will issue invoices within two business days upon receipt of confirmation of registration data; and
- Payment of the balance of the amount due to Football NSW is to be made within 30 days from the date of invoice.
