

1. **Be smart: know the rules:** Read the [FFA National Code of Conduct](#) (Article 4) and [FIFA Code of Ethics](#) (Article 26).
2. **Be safe: never bet on your sport.** All participants in our sport are prohibited from betting on all football matches, all around the world. This includes, for example, A-League, W-League, NPL and English Premier League matches. Betting on a match that you are involved in is a clear-cut conflict of interest.
3. **Be careful: never share sensitive information.** Information about team composition, tactics, player injuries etc. can be used to gain an advantage in the betting market. Take care not to share this information even to family and friends.
4. **Be clean: never fix an event.** Match fixing, or even fixing the outcome of any aspect of the game (e.g. number of yellow cards), is an absolute “No, No”. Always play to the best of your ability.
5. **Be open: tell someone if you are approached.** You must immediately report any offer of a bribe, or approach to you to engage in any prohibited conduct. Failure to do so is a breach of the FFA Code of Conduct.
6. **Be aware: understand the risks.** Unscrupulous characters have been known to target semi-professional footballers. Grooming tactics include befriending players, promising gifts, cash, “sponsorship”. They will also use fear tactics. Report any suspicious approaches.
