2. The Respondent became involved in a melee in breach of 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Offence Code 11-01 of the Regulations.	2. <u>Plea:</u> Guilty. <u>Finding:</u> Guilty <u>Determination:</u> Serve a Time Suspension of one (1) month.
<p>Summary of Sanction:</p> <p><u>The sanctions in Charges 1 and 2 are to be served wholly concurrently such that the Respondent is required to serve a total Time Suspension from all Football Related Activities of three (3) Months.</u></p> <p><u>Please note the start date of the Time Suspension is 13 July 2018.</u></p>	

A suspension from all Football Related Activities is to be served in accordance with section 15.5 of the Regulations, in particular, sub-sections 15.5(a), 15.5(d) and 15.5(e). The term "Football Related Activities" has the meaning given to it in section 15.5(e) of the Regulations.

Please also note that if the Time Suspension proposed coincides with any Non-playing Period(s), pursuant to clauses 12.7 and 12.8 of the FFA National Disciplinary Regulations, then such Non-playing Period(s) will not be counted towards the satisfaction of the Time Suspension. For the avoidance of doubt, a Non-playing Period means a time period between a Club's final match in a League Competition and the Club's next match:

- in the following season of that Competition; or
- in another League Competition.
