

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION.

This document constitutes a Final Notice of Determination resulting from the Tribunal listed above.

Charges against the Respondent under section 8.2 of Football NSW Regulations (Regulations) for alleged breaches by the Respondent of sections 15.4(b), (d) and (f) of the Football NSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations 2016 related to incidents during the NPL Tier 1 Youth U15s trial match between Mt Druitt Town Rangers FC and Spirit FC at Popondetta Park on 26 February 2017.

Summation of the Tribunal:

The Tribunal found that the evidence and admissions:

In part supported the Charges brought against the Respondent.

Determination of the Tribunal:

The Respondent pleaded GUILTY to Charge 1 and NOT GUILTY to Charges 2 and 3.

The Tribunal found the Respondent GUILTY of Charge 1, GUILTY of Charge 2 and NOT GUILTY of Charge 3.

Sanctions Imposed

The Tribunal received insufficient evidence in relation to Charge 1 to make a finding that an offence had occurred.

In relation to Charge 2, the Tribunal imposed sanctions on the Respondent under Schedule 3, Table C, Numbers 3 and 7 – Other Offences by Members: *“Conduct which brings or may bring the game into Disrepute or damage the reputation and goodwill of the game”*, and *“Unsportsmanlike or unprofessional behaviour”*.

The Respondent is suspended for **four (4) Fixtures** from all football related activities in relation to the Charge to be served in accordance with Section 14 of the Regulations.

Fines Imposed

Bonds Imposed

Nil.

Additional Matters and Fees as per the Notice of Costs:

The Respondent is to pay the costs of the Tribunal process as assessed by Football NSW.

A full written Determination will not be produced.

Aggrieved parties to a determination of the FNSW General Purposes Tribunal may lodge an appeal to the FNSW Appeals Tribunal in accordance with sections 8.8 and 9 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations. Any appeal must be submitted on the Notice of Appeal form (Prescribed Form 12) to tribunal@footballnsw.com.au with the relevant Application Fee (\$750) within 7 days of the Final Determination of the GPT being sent to the Respondent.
