- i. enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players and/or officials are likely to assemble to prepare for a match; and*
- ii. be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players and/or officials.*
