Spectators of the Sydney FC (the Club) spat on a Match Official and a Player from Sydney United 58 FC in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Offence Code 17-01 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (Regulations).	1. <u>Plea:</u> Guilty. <u>Finding:</u> Guilty <u>Determination:</u> Pay a \$1,500 fine and a loss of three Competition Points (12 Club Championship Points).
2. Spectators of the Club shouted offensive language at Players from Sydney United 58 FC in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Offence Code 26-01 of the Regulations.	2. <u>Plea:</u> Guilty. <u>Finding:</u> Guilty <u>Determination:</u> Pay a \$1,000 fine and a loss of three Competition Points (12 Club Championship Points) (loss of points to be suspended).

Spectators of the Club instigated a violent melee with Spectators from Sydney United 58 FC in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Offence Code 14-01 of the Regulations.</p>	<p>3. <u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty</p> <p><u>Determination</u>:</p> <p>Pay a \$1,500 fine and a loss of three Competition Points (12 Club Championship Points).</p>
<p>Summary of Sanction:</p> <p>The Club has accepted the proposed sanction issued by Football NSW, that is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A total fine of \$4,000; and • The immediate loss of six (6) Competition Points (24 Club Championship Points) and • The loss of three (3) Competition Points (12 Club Championship Points) but suspended for the duration of the 2017 season (including the Championship, if applicable). <p>If supporters of the Club are found to have committed a similar offence/s (ie, offences involving spitting, using offensive language or violent behaviour) during the remainder of the 2017 season (including the Championship, if applicable) then, in addition to any sanction imposed in respect of the fresh offence/s, the suspended part of the sanction will be activated and the Club will incur a further loss of three Competition Points (12 Club Championship Points).</p>
