### Charge(s) and Determination(s):

<b>Charge(s)</b>	<b>Determination</b>
1. During the NPL2 Youth U14s match between Rydalmere Lions FC and Dulwich Hill FC at Arlington Oval on 16 September 2017, Tony Basha (the <b>Respondent</b> ) failed to abide by or comply with a direction of a Match Official in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Offence Code 01-01 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations ( <b>Regulations</b> ).	1. <u>Plea</u> : Guilty. <u>Finding</u> : Guilty <u>Determination</u> : <b>Four (4) Fixture suspension</b>
2. During the same match, the Respondent then used discriminatory, homophobic, racist, religious, ethnic or sexist language and/or gestures at or towards a Match Official in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Offence Code 08-01 of the Regulations.	2. <u>Plea</u> : Guilty. <u>Finding</u> : Guilty <u>Determination</u> : <b>Eight (8) Fixture suspension</b>

During the NPL2 1st grade final between Rydalmere Lions FC and Fraser Park FC at Sydney United Sports Centre on 24 September 2017, the Respondent coached while serving a Fixture Suspension in breach of section 17.12(b) and section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Offence Code 27-01 of the Regulations.</p>	<p>3. <u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty <u>Determination</u>: <b>Four (4) Fixture suspension</b></p>
<p><b>Serving of Suspension:</b></p> <p><i>The sanctions in Charges 1, 2 and 3 are to be served partly concurrently such that the Respondent is required to serve a total suspension of <b>12 Fixtures</b>.</i></p> <p><i>NB. The Respondent is to serve the suspension as an Official and in accordance with section 15.6 of the Regulations, in particular, sub-sections 15.6(h) and (j) which provide that, on the day of a Fixture, the Respondent must not:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>a. enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players and/or officials are likely to assemble to prepare for a match;</i></li> <li><i>b. be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players and/or officials; and</i></li> <li><i>c. in the case of coach, must not engage or attempt to engage a third party to relay coaching instructions.</i></li> </ul>
