
FOOTBALL NSW NPL YOUTH COMPETITION STRUCTURE 2020



NPL YOUTH COMPETITION TWO-PHASE MODEL



- Clubs for 2020 have been allocated to NPL Youth and NPL 2 Youth based on their Senior program (in this first year only)
- Clubs have been seeded 1 to 24 and 25 to 42 based on their youth results for the 2016-18 seasons. Clubs from 43 to 47 were seeded based on their senior teams' position in the 2019 State League. Newcastle Jets, as a new club entering the competition, is seeded 48.
- Phase 1: NPL Youth and NPL 2 Youth play in two seeded groups for eleven games
- Phase 2: Based on results, Clubs will then move to the applicable tier for another eleven games
- At the end of the season there will be a championship series (4 week, top 5 format)
- Youth Age Grades U13, U14, U15, U16
- Youth Club Championship ages U14, U15 and U16
- Promotion/relegation: the bottom two clubs from Tier 1.2, based on Youth Club Championship, are relegated to NPL 2 Youth. The top two clubs from Tier 2.1, based on Youth Club Championship, are promoted to NPL Youth.
- For the 2021 season the competition resets with seedings based on Youth Club Championship from Phase 2 of the 2020 season

PHASE 1

- Each club plays one match against the other clubs in their Phase 1 group
- At the end of the 11 matches of Phase 1, the top six (based on youth club championship) from each of the Blue and White groups form a group of 12 clubs for Phase 2 (NPL Youth 1.1 and NPL 2 Youth 2.1)
- The bottom six from each of the Blue and White groups form another group of 12 clubs for Phase 2 (NPL Youth 1.2 and NPL 2 Youth 2.2)

PHASE 2

- Each club plays one match against the other clubs in their Phase 2 group thus clubs play another 11 matches
- At the end of Phase 2 there will be a championship series
