### Charge(s) and Determination(s):

Player Y (the <b>Respondent</b> ) used offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures at or towards a Match Official in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Offence Code 04-01 of the FNSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations ( <b>Regulations</b> ).	<u>Plea:</u> Guilty. <u>Finding:</u> Guilty <u>Determination:</u> <b>Four (4) Fixture suspension</b>

### Serving of Suspension:

- Please note the Respondent was issued with an "R3" Red Card for spitting at another Player and as a result of being issued with a Red Card and charged with a Misconduct Offence in the same match, the Respondent is required to serve both suspensions partly consecutively such that the total suspension is **6-Fixtures**.
- The Respondent is to serve the suspension as a Player and in accordance with section 15.6 of the Regulations, in particular, sub-sections 15.6(h) and (j) which provide that, on the day of a Fixture, the Respondent must not:

<p>a. <u>enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players and/or officials are likely to assemble to prepare for a match;</u></p> <p>b. <u>be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players and/or officials; and</u></p> <p>c. <u>in the case of coach, must not provide or attempt to provide coaching instructions or engage or attempt to engage a third party to relay coaching instructions.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>The Club and Club Officials are responsible for ensuring the Respondent correctly and fully serves any Suspension.</u></li><li>• <u>The Club and Club Officials must list in an appropriate place on a team sheet that the Respondent is serving a Suspension at the time the team sheet is completed.</u></li><li>• <u>Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$200 per Participant per match and further sanctions.</u></li></ul>

The Respondent has accepted the determination in lieu of proceeding to a hearing and, in so doing, has waived any right of appeal.
