## Charge(s) and Determination(s):

<b>Charge(s)</b>	<b>Determination</b>
1. Chris Triantis (the <b>Respondent</b> ) received an "R6" Red Card for using offensive, insulting, abusive or intimidating language and/or gestures at or towards a Match Official (isolated Incident) in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Offence Code 04-01 of the Football NSW 2018 Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations ( <b>Regulations</b> ).	<p><u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty</p> <p><u>Determination</u>:</p> <p><b>Five (5) Fixture suspension (this suspension includes a 4-Fixture suspension for the Red Card plus an additional 1-Fixture suspension for the Respondent receiving his second Red Card in the playing season).</b></p>
2. The Respondent used offensive, insulting, abusive or intimidating language and/or gestures at or towards a Match Official (isolated Incident) in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Offence Code 04-01 of Regulations.	<p><u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty</p> <p><u>Determination</u>:</p> <p><b>Four (4) Fixture suspension</b></p>

**Serving of Suspension:**

*As the Respondent has been issued with an "R6" Red Card and committed a misconduct offence in the same match, the Respondent is required to serve both suspensions partly consecutively such that he would serve a total suspension of **6 Fixtures**.*

*NB. The Respondent is to serve the suspension as a Player and in accordance with section 15.6 of the Regulations, in particular, sub-sections 15.6(h) and (j) which provide that, on the day of a Fixture, the Respondent must not:*

- a. enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players and/or officials are likely to assemble to prepare for a match;*
  - b. be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players and/or officials; and*
  - c. in the case of coach, must not engage or attempt to engage a third party to relay coaching instructions.*
- The Club and Club Officials are responsible for ensuring the Respondent correctly and fully serves any Suspension.*
  - The Club and Club Officials must list in an appropriate place on a team sheet that the Respondent is serving a Suspension at the time the team sheet is completed.*
  - Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$200 per Participant per match and further sanctions.*
