**Subject:** Midseason Registration Window – Seniors (U20, Res, 1<sup>st</sup> Grade)



#### Overview

The purpose of this memo serves to clarify the post COVID-19 Player Registration Windows for Football NSW Competitions (Men's and Women's Seniors) ahead of the re-commencement of the season.

## **Player Registrations**

- a) All registrations must be submitted via Play Football, with allocation to the respective team, and a passport style photo (head and shoulders ONLY) is to be uploaded into the Player or Team Official's profile within the communicated registration period; and
- b) All Clubs must notify the relevant <u>FNSW Competitions Coordinator</u> upon the completion of registrations for all new Players, Coaches and Team Officials.

On the Closing Date of each registration period; registrations must be lodged by no later than **5.00pm**.

Note: No player that is age eligible is permitted to play down into the U18, U16, U15, U14, U13 age grade if that player was registered with the Club's U20 or 1st Grade team during the mid-season registration window		

### **Exemptions for Registrations Outside of Registration Periods**

Requests for registrations falling outside the Registration windows outlined above must be made via the following online form.

The respective registration packages are now open for registrations to occur.

#### Player Point System (PPS) - Men's

The Player Point System (**PPS**) for NPL NSW Men's, NPL 2 NSW Men's and NPL 3 NSW Men's will continue to be applied for the 2020 season. Acknowledging the impact COVID-19 has had on Clubs and the respective Competitions, the following concessions will be applied for the 2020 season **only**:

- Switching Player:
  - Zero (0) points are added to, or deducted from, a Player's points value if he was previously registered as a professional or amateur regardless of whether the player is switching from an NPL or Non-NPL Club:
    - That same Player will incur the relevant switching player points for the 2021 season if the Player was registered with the Club during the 2020 registration window and is retained by the Club;

 Zero (0) points are added to, or deducted from, a Player's points value if a Player sits out or plays for a different clubs during the 2020 season and returns to the same Club that the Player was registered to pre-Covid–19.

#### Loyalty Player:

 One (1) point will be deducted from a Player's points value for the 2020 season if that Player is unable to continue the 2020 post Covid-19 and returns to the same Club he was registered to pre-Covid-19.

#### 40% of matches:

 The article of the PPS regulations relating to 40% of matches and requiring a Player to remain on the PPS roster once reaching this limit, will not be applied for the 2020 season.

#### Player Point System (PPS) - Women's

The PPS for NPL NSW Women's and NPL 2 NSW Women's will continue to be applied for the 2020 season. Acknowledging the impact COVID-19 has had on Clubs and the respective Competitions, the following concessions will be applied for the 2020 season only:

#### Switching Player:

- Zero (0) points are added to, or deducted from, a Player's points value if she was previously registered as a professional or amateur regardless of whether the Player is switching from an NPL or Non-NPL Club:
  - That same Player will incur the relevant switching player points for the 2021 season if the Player was registered with the Club during the 2020 registration window and is retained by the Club.
