PERSONAL ACCIDENT INSURANCE

The Football NSW Personal Accident Insurance covers team managers, referees, coaches, committee members, directors, office bearers, administrators, selectors, medical officers, physiotherapists, ambulance officers, voluntary workers and other match officials that are injured while engaged in activities sanctioned by Football NSW.

There are three categories of participants and an overview of the policy for each participant category is below:

Category 1 – Participants aged eighteen (18) years or older at the date of injury while engaged in:

- 1. Participating in official matches or training;
- Travelling to participate in representative matches or authorised games;
- 3. Travelling directly to or from home and one of the activities (a) or (b).

Category 2 – Participants aged eighteen (18) years or older at the date of injury while engaged in:

- 1. Fundraising activities;
- 2. Administrative or organised social activities;
- 3. Unpaid voluntary work;
- 4. Travelling directly to or from home and one of the activities (a)-(c).

Category ${\bf 3}$ – Participants aged under eighteen (18) years at the date of injury, and engaged in:

- 1. Participating in official matches or training;
- 2. Travelling to participate in representative matches or authorised games;
- 3. Fundraising activities;
- 4. Administrative or organised social activities;
- 5. Unpaid voluntary work;
- 6. Travelling directly to or from home and one of the activities (a) or (e).

Category 1, 2 & 3 Benefits

Non-Medicare Medical Benefits

Physiotherapy, chiropractic, remedial massage, acupuncture, private hospital accommodation, ambulance, emergency department private hospital admission (Excess \$50/nil if member of a health fund)

(Physiotherapy must be certified by a Doctor or Specialist as being necessary after every six visits)

Additional Benefits

Rehabilitation Benefit (Quadriplegia/Paraplegia only), Reimbursement of membership fees (pro rata), Bed care.

Other Benefits

Travel and accommodation expenses, local transportation (e.g. taxis) for travel between your home and place of treatment, gym or pool membership (if referred by a treating Doctor, funeral expenses and out-of-pocket expenses; for example:

Appliances/prosthesis, medical aids (knee braces, crutches, wheelchair hire)

Capital Benefits

Quadriplegia / Paraplegia and Accidental death.

Additional Individual Category Benefits

Category 1 - Injury Inconvenience Benefit.
Category 2 & 3 - Loss of Income weekly benefit. Excess 7 days (Refer Category summary brochures for claimable amounts.)
