Minimum Coaching Qualifications

- a) Following are the minimum coaching qualifications required by Coaches for each respective League and grade of the Competitions:
- b) Coaches must be qualified in order to obtain the Coaching ID card.
- c) Failure to comply with any part of Section 4 Article 20 of the 2022 FNSW Competition Regulations will result in a fine to the Club. The amount fined will be equal to the cost of the required coaching course(s).
- i. The fine will be allocated towards the next available course required providing that course is during the current football calendar year. For example, a coach that is required to have a B Licence prior to the commencement of the 2022 season however only has a C Licence Senior qualification, the club will be fined \$2,420. If a B Licence is available in the month of April and the coach enrolls to attend the B Licence course, the fine of \$2,420 will be allocated to cover the cost of that course.

Mandatory Technical Director and Coach Registrations

a) Technical Directors

- i. Appointment of a Technical Director in the NPL NSW Men's, Football NSW Men's League One, Football NSW Men's League Two, Football NSW Men's League Three, Football NSW Boys' Youth League One, Football NSW Boys' Youth League Two, Football NSW Boys' Youth League Three, NPL NSW Women's, Football NSW Women's League One, Football NSW Girls' Youth League One, Football NSW Girls' Youth League Two, Football NSW Girls' Skill Acquisition and the Football NSW Skill Acquisition Program is mandatory
- ii. All Technical directors are to be registered through the National Registration System
- iii. If the Technical Director is employed by the Club on a full-time contract, the Club is open to expand his / her role beyond the scope of the Technical Director (i.e. in administration, coaching additional teams, coaching in SAP etc), so long as his / her ability to perform the Technical Director role is not compromised
- iv. If the Technical Director is employed on a part time basis, they are able to be registered to perform one of the following roles in addition to their role as the Club Technical Director;
 - a. Be registered to Coach one of the U13-U18 teams at the Club; or
 - b. Be Registered to the Technical Director role for the Club's Girls' SAP and SAP; or
 - c. Be registered to Coach one of the Club's Girls' SAP and SAP teams; or
 - d. Be registered as Head coach of any single grade + assistant coach of any single grade.

b) Head Coaches

- i. Appointment of individual head coaches to all grades of all Leagues is mandatory and all coaches are to be registered through the National Registration System
- ii. Head coaches of any grade will be permitted to be registered to additionally coach in the following capacities within a Club:
 - a. Head coach of any single grade + coach of any single grade in Girls' SAP and SAP; or
 - b. Head coach of any single grade + Technical Director in Girls' SAP and SAP
- iii. Where a coach's position is terminated from a mandatory role, as outlined in Section 4 art. 19 (pg.38) of the FNSW Competition Regulations, Clubs will be given a maximum of four (4) weeks to appoint a new, fully accredited coach failure to do so will result in a fine. The amount fined will be equal to the cost of the required coaching course(s) for the position that is vacant.

c) Assistant Coaches and Goalkeeper Coaches

- i. Appointment of assistant coaches and goalkeeper coaches to all Leagues is optional. Should either be appointed they must meet the relevant minimum standard and be registered on the National Registration System

d) All Coaches must be registered through the National Registration System by close of business Friday 4 February 2022. Failure to comply with this or other minimum coaching accreditation will result in a fine to the club as detailed in Section 4 art. 20 b)

e) All Clubs must ensure that their Coaching Roster details are kept up to date and any changes must be communicated via email to the Football NSW Competitions Department within 7 days of any change occurring (e.g coach termination, update in accreditation, submission of PBTR Certificates etc.)
