CCM will be placed on a Good Behaviour Bond in the amount of \$2,000 for a period of two (2) years (Bond). If CCM, its Players or Club/Team Officials are found to be in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Offence Codes 11-01 to 14-01 for offences committed during the course of the 2022 or 2023 seasons, this Bond will be forfeited to Football NSW in addition to any sanctions applicable to the fresh offence/s.</p>
