<p><b>Serving of Suspension:</b> <u>The sanctions in Charges 1, 2 and 3 are to be served partly consecutively such that the Respondent is required to serve a total suspension of <b>Six (6) Fixtures.</b></u> <u>NB. The Respondent is to serve the suspension as a Spectator and in accordance with section 15.6 of the Regulations, in particular, sub-section 15.6(k) which provides that the Respondent must not enter a stadium, venue, ground or Centre during a Fixture until that Suspension is served in full. A Fixture Suspension imposed on a Participant as a Spectator will be served in full in accordance with section 15.6.</u></p>
