Charge(s) and Determination(s):

Charge(s)	Determination
1. During the match, supporters of Nepean FC (the Club) ignited a flare in breach of section 16.4(e) of the Football NSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (Regulations); namely section 2, subsection 3(c) and 3(d) of the Football NSW Stadium Technical Requirements 2017 Competitions and section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table C, Offence Code 25-01 of the Regulations.	Plea: Guilty. Finding: Guilty Determination: Pay a \$1,000 fine and the loss of three (3) Competition Points (12 Club Championship Points) (loss of points to be suspended).

Summary of Sanction:

The Club has accepted the proposed sanction set out in the Notice of Charge issued by Football NSW; that is:

- Pay a total fine of \$1,000; and
- The loss of three (3) Competition Points (12 Club Championship Points) but suspended for the duration of the 2017 season.

If supporters of the Club are found to have committed similar offences (ie, offences involving flares, incendiary devices or any offences involving Prohibited Items (see Section 2, Subsection 3 of the Football NSW Stadium Technical Requirements 2017 Competitions)) during the remainder of the 2017 season, then, in addition to any sanction imposed in respect of the fresh offences, the suspended part of the sanction will be activated and the Club will incur a loss of 3 Competition Points (12 Club Championship Points).
