- *i.* <u>taking to the Field of Play (or court) as a Player or Match Official in any match or</u> <u>competition sanctioned or administered by Football NSW, Clubs, Centres,</u> <u>Association Members or their clubs;</u>
- *ii.* <u>taking a position as a coach, Team Official or Club Official in any match or</u> <u>competition sanctioned or administered by Football NSW, Clubs, Centres,</u> <u>Association Members or their clubs;</u>
- iii. <u>entering the Field of Play (or court), its surrounds, the Technical Area, players race,</u> <u>dressing rooms or any other place within a venue on a match day where players,</u> <u>coaches or Officials are likely to assemble to prepare for a match;</u>
- iv. <u>taking part as a player, coach, Team Official or Club Official in any training session</u> <u>conducted by or for a team or club participating in any matches or competitions</u> <u>sanctioned or administered by Football NSW, Clubs, Centres, Association Members</u> <u>or their clubs;</u>
- v. <u>acting in any way as a Team Official, Club Official or Association Member Official,</u> <u>including, but not limited to, participating in or carrying on any function as a member</u> <u>of a committee, sub-committee or board of directors (whether paid, voluntary or</u> <u>honorary) at any level (to the extent such a restraint is permissible by law);</u>
- vi. <u>attending any function or event coordinated, conducted or sanctioned by Football</u> <u>NSW; and/or</u>
- vii. <u>entering a stadium venue, ground or Centre during any match, competition or training</u> <u>session sanctioned or administered by Football NSW, Clubs, Centres, Association</u> <u>Members or their clubs.</u>

<u>Please note that if the Time Suspension proposed coincides with any Non-playing Period(s)</u> then, pursuant to clauses 13.7 and 13.8 of the FFA National Disciplinary Regulations, such Nonplaying Period(s) will not be counted towards the satisfaction of the Time Suspension.
