- enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players and/or officials are likely to assemble;
- b. be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players and/or officials;
- c. have any contact with a Match Official;

- The Club and Club Officials must list in an appropriate place on a team sheet that the Respondent is serving a Suspension at the time the team sheet is completed.
- Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$200 per Participant per match and further sanctions.
