Tommy Markovski (the Respondent) used offensive, insulting, abusive or intimidating language and/or gestures at or towards a Match Official (isolated Incident) in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table B, Offence Code 04-01 of the Football NSW 2018 Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (Regulations).	<u>Plea</u> : Guilty. <u>Finding</u> : Guilty <u>Determination:</u> Four (4) Fixture suspension

## **Serving of Suspension:**

As the Respondent has been issued with an "R7" Red Card and committed a misconduct offence in the same match, the Respondent is required to serve both suspensions wholly concurrently such that he would serve a total suspension of **4 Fixtures**.

NB. The Respondent is to serve the suspension as a Player and in accordance with section 15.6 of the Regulations, in particular, sub-sections 15.6(h) and (j) which provide that, on the day of a Fixture, the Respondent must not:

a. enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players and/or officials are likely to assemble to prepare for a match;

- b. be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players and/or officials; and
- c. in the case of coach, must not engage or attempt to engage a third party to relay coaching instructions.
- The Club and Club Officials are responsible for ensuring the Respondent correctly and fully serves any Suspension.
- The Club and Club Officials must list in an appropriate place on a team sheet that the Respondent is serving a Suspension at the time the team sheet is completed.
- Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$200 per Participant per match and further sanctions.
