- <u>Please note the Respondent was issued with an "R3" Red Card for spitting at another Player</u> and as a result of being issued with a Red Card and charged with a Misconduct Offence in the same match, the Respondent is required to serve both suspensions partly consecutively such that the total suspension is **6-Fixtures**.
- <u>The Respondent is to serve the suspension as a Player and in accordance with section 15.6</u> of the Regulations, in particular, sub-sections 15.6(h) and (j) which provide that, on the day of <u>a Fixture, the Respondent must not:</u>

- a. <u>enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing</u> <u>rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players</u> <u>and/or officials are likely to assemble to prepare for a match;</u>
- b. <u>be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players</u> <u>and/or officials; and</u>
- c. <u>in the case of coach, must not provide or attempt to provide coaching instructions or</u> <u>engage or attempt to engage a third party to relay coaching instructions.</u>
- <u>The Club and Club Officials are responsible for ensuring the Respondent correctly and fully</u> <u>serves any Suspension.</u>
- <u>The Club and Club Officials must list in an appropriate place on a team sheet that the</u> <u>Respondent is serving a Suspension at the time the team sheet is completed.</u>
- Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$200 per Participant per match and further sanctions.
