Aleks Trenoski (the <b>Respondent</b> ) used offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures in frustration towards a Match Official in breach of section 16.4(d), Table B, Offence Code 03-01 of the Football NSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations 2020 ( <b>Regulations</b> ).	<ol> <li><u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty <u>Determination:</u> Two (2) Fixtures Suspension.</li> </ol>

#### NB.

The Respondent is to serve the suspension as a Player and in accordance with section 15.6 of the Regulations, in particular, sub-sections 15.6(h)-(j) which provide that, on the day of a Fixture, the Respondent must <u>not</u>:

- a. enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players and/or officials are likely to assemble;
- b. be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players and/or officials;
- c. have any contact with a Match Official;
- In accordance with section 15.3 of the Regulations, the Club and Club Officials are responsible for ensuring the Respondent correctly and fully serves any Suspension.
- A Club and/or Club Official in breach of section 15.3 will be deemed to have committed Misconduct (section 16.4) and the Executive may, in its absolute discretion, take any relevant action pursuant to section 9.2

- The Club and Club Officials must list in an appropriate place on a team sheet that the Respondent is serving a Suspension at the time the team sheet is completed.
- Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$200 per Participant per match and further sanctions.
