Charge(s)	Tribunal determination
<p>1. In or about the 44th minute of the Match, SGC Player Tarik Ercan (the Respondent) punched CCM Player Jaden Casella, in the side of the torso, in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table A, Red Card R2, Offence Code 01-01 of the Football NSW Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations (Regulations).</p>	<p>1. <u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty <u>Determination</u>: Two (2) Fixture Suspension (as determined by the GPT at the hearing).</p>
<p>2. In the final minutes of the Match, a confrontation occurred between Players and Officials from both Clubs. During that confrontation, the Respondent was grabbed and pushed by a number of CCM Players. Feeling threatened and intimidated, the Respondent lashed out and punched a CCM Player in the face, causing bodily harm, namely a punctured tongue, in breach of in breach of section 16.4(d), Schedule 3, Table A, Red</p>	<p>2. <u>Plea</u>: Guilty. <u>Finding</u>: Guilty <u>Determination</u>: Six (6) Fixture Suspension.</p>

<p><u>Serving of Suspension:</u></p> <p><i>Given all of the circumstances of this case, a concession has been made to allow for the Respondent's sanctions for Charges 1 and 2 to be served concurrently, and not consecutively, as may have otherwise been the case.</i></p> <p><i>The sanctions in relation to Charges 1 and 2 are to be served wholly concurrently such that the Respondent is required to serve a total suspension of 6 Fixtures.</i></p> <p><i>For clarity, the Respondent will be entitled to participate in all pre-season matches and will only commence serving his suspension in Round 1 of the competition in which he is participating in for the 2022 season.</i></p> <p><i>The Respondent is to serve the Suspension as a Player and in accordance with section 15.6 of the Regulations, in particular, sub-sections 15.6(h)-(j) which provide that, on the day of a Fixture, the Respondent must <u>not</u>:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>a. enter the field of play (or court), its surrounds, the technical area, players race, dressing rooms or any other place within a stadium, venue, ground or Centre where players and/or officials are likely to assemble;</i> <i>b. be seated in an area in a stadium, venue, ground or Centre normally reserved for players and/or officials;</i> <i>c. have any contact with a Match Official;</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>• In accordance with section 15.3 of the Regulations, the Club and Club Officials are responsible for ensuring the Respondent correctly and fully serves any Suspension.</i> <i>• A Club and/or Club Official in breach of section 15.3 will be deemed to have committed Misconduct (section 16.4) and the Executive may, in its absolute discretion, take any relevant action pursuant to section 9.2</i> <i>• The Club and Club Officials must list in an appropriate place on a team sheet that the Respondent is serving a Suspension at the time the team sheet is completed.</i> <i>• Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$200 per Participant per match and further sanctions.</i>
