All fees and charges listed below are GST inclusive. Unless stated otherwise, the participant is covered under the Football NSW Insurance Program and the NSW Government Sporting Injuries Insurance Scheme.

### **Important Information**

#### **Football NSW Capitation Component, Insurance Component and FA National Registration Fee**

The Football NSW Registration Fee represents the financial contribution registered participants make to Football NSW to enable it to provide a wide range of programs, benefits and services to them and to the broader football community.

The Football NSW Registration Fee is made up of an Insurance Component and a Capitation Component.

The Insurance Component is the amount that we collect from each participant in order to cover the cost of the Football NSW Insurance Program which provides benefits including Personal Accident cover. The Capitation Component goes towards covering all of the other costs incurred by Football NSW in delivering services to its membership.

We advise that Football Australia (**FA**) will not be increasing the National Registration Fee (**NRF**) for the 2024 season, the NRF is \$14.50 for Juniors, \$34.00 for Seniors and \$67.50 for Professionals.

#### **Capped Player Registration Fees**

Clubs participating in Football NSW Competitions are required to comply with the capped Player Registration Fees set by Football NSW for certain competition and age grades.
