TERM OF POSITION AND REQUIREMENT:

The FNSW Female Para Football Program Head Coach and Assistant Coach will be employed by Football NSW on a casual basis.

ROLE PURPOSE

The FNSW Female Para Football Program Coaches will manage the individual development of selected female Para Football players in NSW. The Coaches will create and prepare sustainable session within the FNSW Female Para Football program in order to facilitate a quality football experience to support developing players. The Coaches should therefore have experience in coaching players with cerebral palsy, acquired brain injury (ABI), and stroke-related symptoms.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- Lead, prepare and deliver structured training sessions for the FNSW Female Para Football Program in consultation with Football NSW Head of Women's Football, & Head of Community & Member Services and Football Australia CommBank ParaMatildas coaching staff.
- Implement, coordinate and coach the FNSW Female Para Football Program within the FNSW region in accordance with national and local objectives.
- The FNSW Female Para Football coach is expected to be available for other activities within Football NSW as determined by the Head of Women's Football or Head of Community & Member Services.
- Actively participate in FNSW meetings and/or events and contribute to the development of programs that support the development of NSW players with a disability.
- Share knowledge and provide input to the technical direction of underpinning programs.



- Preserve a safe and inclusive environment within the FNSW Female Para Football Program for players and coaches.
- Provide continual and ongoing feedback to players by way of individual development plans as provide and determined by Football NSW.
- Prepare and maintain reports, records, and documentation while providing administrative support to the FNSW Para Football Program operations and activities.
