Summer 2026/27 Social Football Registration Fees (GST Inclusive)			
Age Grade	Insurance Component	Capitation Component	Football NSW Fee
Junior	\$2.40	\$5.60	\$8.00
Senior	\$8.58	\$19.42	\$28.00

- Junior players are those turning up to 18 by 31st December in the calendar year in which the season commences (2026 for Summer 2026/27)
- Senior players are those turning 19 and above by 31st December in the calendar year in which the season commences (2026 for Summer 2026/27)
- Registration fees are inclusive of all levies and insurance policies.
- Players are **only** covered by the Football NSW Insurance Program if they are already registered at time of injury. Players who are **not** registered may have their claims denied.
- Social Football means small-sided (e.g.; 4v4, 5v5, 6v6, 7v7) modified games, including Walking Football

Registration and Competition periods

The registration and competition periods for the **Summer Football Season** are as follows:

- Registrations open July 2026
- Competitions commence no earlier than 1 September 2026
- Competitions conclude no later than 31 March 2027

Registration process

All players participating in an approved Social Football competition must be registered to the relevant competition online through the prescribed online registration system.

In addition to providing helpdesk support, FNSW issues registration guidelines to assist competition operators and participants to navigate the online registration process.

Eligibility for refunds of Football NSW Registration Fees:**Cancelled and Declined Registrations:**

Players whose registration is Cancelled (the player cancels their registration application) or Declined (the centre declines the registration application) will be eligible for a refund.

Deregistration Deadline:

The Deregistration Deadline is the date the competitions are due to start – if a player has had their registration approved, but their deregistration is completed on or prior to the Deregistration Deadline, they will be eligible for a refund of the Football NSW Registration Fee.
